

How to reach the Nuclear Decommissioning Authority - Harwell Office

By Road

The Nuclear Decommissioning Authority (NDA) is situated on the Harwell Science and Innovation Campus on the A4185 approximately mid-way between Newbury and Oxford. Approach from the north and south via the A34.

If approaching from the north, leave the A34 at the Milton Interchange (Didcot, Milton) and follow the signs for the A4130 (Steventon, Chilton, Wantage, Harwell). If approaching from the south, leave the A34 at the Chilton Exit for the A4185 (Wantage).

Visitors to the NDA should turn off the A4185 into Curie Avenue (signposted 'Harwell Science and Innovation Campus North') and continue until reaching Lloyds Bank. Turn right immediately after the bank and right again after the car park (sign-posted Building 587). Car parking for visitors is available only in the designated areas opposite Reception.

By Rail

The NDA is 5 miles south-west of Didcot-Parkway, from which there are frequent connections with London (Paddington), Birmingham, West of England and South Wales. Visitors can be met at Didcot by arrangement.

On Arrival

All visitors must report to Reception. A visitor's pass will be issued which must be worn at all times and returned to the Reception desk before leaving.
